DRESS REHEARSAL: MAY 30 & 31

Class Rehearsal Times Are TBA

Please be present in the auditorium 15 minutes
before the time designated on the rehearsal
schedule, in costume for your first dance. If
you have more than one costume, bring the
additional costumes on a hanger. Dancers may
change costumes in the vocal music room.

Please put your child's name in her costumes,
shoes, and all accessories.

Signs will be posted at the end of each row of
seats indicating where each class will sit.

Please sit with your daughter in the row with
her class. An adult must accompany each
child. We will bring the dancers from the
audience to the stage to rehearse, they will
then be returned to the audience.

This is a Dress Rehearsal.

Bring all costume pieces, tights and dance
shoes. The order of the dances to be
rehearsed will be posted on the side walls of
the auditorium. No food or drink may be
consumed in the auditorium. You and your
dancer may go to the cafeteria area if you
need a snack. Dress rehearsal is also a time for
the children to see the other dances in the
show. We ask that you stay seated with your
class for most of the time and be courteous to
the dancers who are rehearsing on stage.

Rehearsal takes time so please plan
accordingly.

RECITAL: JUNE 1 & 2

Dressing Rooms for the recital will be the vocal music room and the band room. High school students will change in the backstage dressing rooms. There will be signs on the dressing room doors indicating which classes are in each room. Take time at rehearsal to locate your child's dressing room, to save time when you are dropping her off for the recital.

Hair and Make-Up: All dancers should have their hair neatly pulled back away from the face and secured. Long hair must be pulled up off the neck. Please keep hats and headpieces in mind when deciding on a hair style. Apply mascara, blush and lipstick so your child will not look pale under the bright lights on stage. Please do not use glitter eye shadow, or spray glitter in your child's hair. Students should not wear jewelry while in costume.

Recital Instructions:

Please bring your child to her dressing room, in costume and make up, ready for the first dance, no sooner than 30 min. before the performance.

Dressing rooms will not be open until 30 min. prior to the performance. It is very hard for the children to have to wait in the dressing rooms any longer before the show. If you have additional costumes, please bring them on a hanger, and put additional shoes and accessories in a bag or plastic bin.

We have adequate supervision in the dressing rooms and backstage. Our staff will assist with any costume changes. Label all costumes, shoes and accessories with your child's name. You may pick up your child at her dressing room after the recital is over. Parents of 3 and 4 year old students should pick up their child at intermission.

Parent Volunteers:

In order to have better supervision of the children in the dressing rooms before the show, we are asking for parent volunteers for each dressing room.

Volunteers should report to the dressing room 45 min. before the show and stay with the children until they are taken to the stage. You may go to the auditorium to watch your child dance with her class and then return to the dressing room to help with the next costume change or wait for the children to be picked up.

Seating: We have three recital performances to ensure ample seating for our audiences. The auditorium doors will open 30 min. prior to the performance. Please invite friends and neighbors to the show as our recital is the best advertisement for our studio.

Ticket sales begin May 8, at 9:00am.

Please be courteous to the performers and others in the audience by reminding your friends and family of proper theater etiquette. Applause during and after performances is greatly appreciated. Do not enter or exit the auditorium during a number, please do this in between numbers if you must. When entering and exiting the auditorium please use the doors in the back of the auditorium. Opening the side doors is very distracting to the dancers on stage.

Costumes: may not be worn in the audience. If your child has finished her numbers by intermission, she must change into street clothes before going to the auditorium with you. You may leave her costume in the dressing room. This ensures a professional quality performance.

For an itemized list of what you will need for recital per class, please refer to the recital packet listed on the website.

A checklist will be included to be printed off at home.

*Reminder: All costumes should be wrinkle free. Please do not use an iron as that may possibly ruin the costume. Alternate methods such as using a steamer or hanging up the costumes in your bathroom during a shower are recommended.

Flowers and Gift Items: BDC is offering a new flower company this year in lieu of real flowers. Visit the "All Things Fancy" facebook page and instagram to see examples of these beautiful wooden flowers. a small bouquet will be on display at the front desk. Prices will range from \$15-25 and you dancer can keep them forever. Visit their table in the commons area, before the performance and during intermission. We will not run out of flowers.

Recital Videos:

No video cameras will be allowed at the performance due to exclusive rights of Mr. Video Productions.

Flash photos are not allowed during the performance.

Please inform your guests of this policy.

You are allowed to video your child's class during **dress rehearsal** only.
